

**METER RENTAL & WATER HYDRANT USAGE POLICY ON  
ENTRANOSA WATER & WASTEWATER ASSOCIATION

Entranosa Water & Wastewater Association is a non-profit community water system. We will serve all reasonable requests for water service on our service area and for our service area including contractors that wish to pull water from the fire hydrants within our service. We will provide service that meets all State and County requirements.

If a customer wishes to purchase water from Entranosa by means of utilizing a hydrant meter, they must set up an account in our office before pulling water from any water hydrants within our service area. At the time an account is set up, the hydrant user will receive a certificate from Entranosa, indicating they have permission to pull water from various water hydrants. Entranosa employees, members, the Sheriff, and Fire Department employees, all, may ask to see this certificate any time an individual is seen pulling water from a fire hydrant, therefore, **These certificates must be kept with the individual pulling water from the hydrant.**

**METER RENTAL & WATER USER**

If the contractor would like to rent a hydrant meter to pull water from the fire hydrants, they are available from Entranosa's office for a \$500.00 refundable deposit and a fee of \$80.00 plus tax per month. The deposit will be refunded when the meter is returned in the same condition when issued. Water charges are \$7.50 per thousand gallons. There will be an initial reading at the time the meter is picked up. **On the 26<sup>th</sup> of each month, it is the contractor's responsibility to bring the meter into the office so that we may get a physical reading off the meter.** There is a \$50.00 penalty applied to all accounts that do not turn in a reading by the 26<sup>th</sup> of each month. Once the meter is returned to our office, the meter will be read for a final bill and the contractor will be charged for any difference from the previous reading. The contractor is responsible for any damages to the meter. The rental meter is for use on Entranosa's system only. If the meter is used outside Entranosa's serving area, the contractor will still be responsible to Entranosa for any reading differences indicated on the register. **Entranosa's Hydrant Meters are to be used only on Entranosa's system.**

**WATER USER ONLY**

A contractor may use their own hydrant meter or water truck, however, they must set up an account with Entranosa before pulling water from a fire hydrant within the Entranosa system. At the time the account is set up, a certificate will be issued for the water user with an expiration date of the 26<sup>th</sup> of the month. There is a charge of \$16.00 per month plus the water charges. Water charges are \$7.50 per thousand gallons. The contractor is responsible for reporting all readings to the office of Entranosa every month for usage pulled from the hydrant meter. All contractors are responsible for bringing the unit into the office for verification of readings. This account must be updated monthly. **If we have meters available, we require use of the meter from Entranosa Water.**

**FINES**

If a user is caught pulling water from one of our hydrants without previously setting up an account, or notifying Entranosa, they will be fined \$500.00.
