

# **METER & MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION**

**Entranosa is a membership-owned cooperative association. We are authorized to provide service ONLY to members of Entranosa or their tenants.**

**Regular Household Meters are \$875.00 as of April 30, 2005.**

Prior to installing a meter, the membership must be paid in full, unless noted by contract. We also require a current non-transferable water agreement and current membership agreement signed by the member before installation will begin. A copy of the warranty deed or the original membership certificate (issued before 1997), must be provided if the member is transferring a vacant lot with a current membership.

Pricing for other than regular household meters are determined on a case-by-case basis.

We will not install meters for builders unless the owner has filled out all current paperwork, and transferred their membership properly. If the builder is the owner, they must fill out the paperwork and transfer all certificates accordingly.

There is a \$33.00 transfer fee for all transfers. We will not hold a membership until the home sells. All memberships must be assigned and all transfers must be done in the following manner in order to transfer liability of ownership:

1. If the member is selling the property, they must return the original membership Certificate (issued before 1997) or the original membership agreement.
2. A copy of the warranty deed, Settlement agreement or real estate contract must be on file.
3. A current water contract and membership agreement must be signed.
4. A final water reading must be done at least 48 hours before closing. We prefer to handle this transaction through the escrow agent.
5. The \$33.00 transfer fee must be paid.

**All memberships stay with the property and are non-transferable from one lot or tract to another.**
