BYLAWS OF ENTRANOSA WATER AND WASTEWATER ASSOCIATION August 22, 2019
ARTICLE 1
Names, Objectives, Purposes and Principal Place of Business
The name of the organization shall be Enfrancea Water and Wastewater Association (a Coopenzitive Association) (Association' or "Entrances"). The objectives, purposes and the principal place of business of this Association shall be as stated and provided for in the Articles of Incorporation.
ARTICLE II
Seal
The seal of the Association shall have inscribed thereon the name of the Association and the words "A Cooperative Association" and the date of original incorporation, "1981".
ARTICLE III
Fiscal Year
The fiscal year of the Association shall begin on the first day of January in each year.
ARTICLE IV

Also on the Annual meeting ballot is a proposed By-law change, contained in Article IV Membership, Section 1. This proposed change is to add flexibility in transferring memberships from one parcel to another. Current language states: "Memberships will only be granted to a deeded parcel of land and may not be transferred to another parcel." The change the Board of Directors would like the membership to consider is to allow the Board to approve transfers pursuant to an

established membership transfer policy. An example would be: A member owns one parcel with a membership and another without a membership. If both parcels are owned by the same owner and are undeveloped without a meter, the Board could approve the transfer. Currently, the Board has no authority to approve such a transfer. A draft of this proposed transfer policy will be included in the package to be sent to members August

Costs of Doing Business

In 2020, Santa Fe County passed a new

road requirement that has sky rocketed the costs of repairs and connections. This San Pablo Road repair has increased costs from less than \$2,000 to over \$10,000. In October 2020, EMW gas General Manager, Eddie O'Brien, sent notice to customers that the new requirement will add over \$2,000 to future connections. For future road crossing connections, Entranosa will require new customers to pay for a road bore which will cost an additional \$3,000-\$5,000.
